AZ NCRC Board of Directors Meeting Highlights – February 12, 2009

- The Arizona chapter fall meet date and location was discussed. *Current update-date and location still being determined.*
- New chapter apparel with the new logo update. Since the last email there has been a lot of interest. Mike will send out to bid next week and forward the bids to the Board. The goal is good quality, low price, ability for member to choose color, and to purchase on demand (no minimums) going forward. Dave suggested to award members with chapter apparel for chapter accomplishments. Also, the Board agreed that Board members will be given one shirt with their Board position embroidered on it. Mike mentioned that he has a signed copyright transfer agreement for the logo that he will give to Tom at the next event.
- Tom talked about the need for some more judging schools. Mike will host two in Tucson on his '57. One for the chassis/mechanical in about a month and one for the body/drop 2 to 4 weeks thereafter.
- The desire to increase Christmas party attendance was brought up. The chapter will try one more year in Casa Grande before possibly going back to the Phoenix/Tucson alternate schedule again. A chapter shirt promotion was mentioned where a member will earn a free shirt if they attend the two chapter meets, two judging schools, and the Christmas party all in the same calendar year. Also mentioned was

how well the auction event was at last year's Christmas party and to bring more items this year. Next Christmas party date will be **December 13, 2009**.
