Time for our event is quickly approaching! I'm sending you this update to try to make this the best experience possible.

Registered Car and Trailer registration and check in:

All Car registration will occur in the tent set up in the Operations parking lot

Recently, I sent a notice requesting that PV & Judged cars arrive early, to avoid the heat of the day on Thursday. We will have early registration open around 3pm on Wednesday. We would like to see all cars on site by Noon Thursday at the very latest.

Please see accompanying maps for orientation and where to park.

Security will be provided starting Wednesday evening in the venues westside parking lot.

Security ends Sunday at 6am

Flight Judged and Founders Ops Cars will have the Operations checks done Thursday starting around 8am in the Westside parking lot. All cars will be photographed, and the Flight Judged cars will be directed to the entrance of the Convention Center.

Performance Verification (PV) Cars will be parked in the designated area. Owners should contact their respective team lead to schedule the time for your PV.

Sportsman Display cars will have in and out privileges and should park in the Sportsman parking area

What to expect: Flight, Founders Ops & Concours Judging

Car registration will occur in the tent set up in the Operations parking lot

Wednesday May 16th Early registration begins around 3pm

Security will be provided Wednesday evening in the venues westside parking lot.

Thursday May 17th

Registration opens at 8:00am. You should arrive early; Operations' Judging starts around 8am and consists of two judges and continues to completion of all cars.

NOTE: Cold Start verification is required!! AND VERY IMPORTANT: No more than ¼ tank of gas.

We will not have any provisions to remove excess fuel so: Plan accordingly & Arrive early!

Upon completion of "Ops", you will be directed to the photo booth and to your final parking place. Make sure your dash card is in place always. Please write your cell number on the card.

Friday and Saturday May 18-19

Look for the posted schedule for the day that your car is being judged. You will have four teams of two judges each, with the possibility of observer judges. Each team will cover one section of your score sheets in no particular order; Interior, Exterior, Mechanical and Chassis.

It may seem like an eternity between judging teams, however, be assured the team leader is trying to keep them moving at a steady pace.

The judges will ask you for the judging sheet relating to the area that they are judging. They will be in the envelope that you received when you checked in.

***You will need to remove some items from the car for judging, air cleaner, ignition shielding, lower and remove the spare and jack.

Please bring everything you need (tools etc.) to accomplish this task.

PLEASE... let the judges do their work; the judges will ask you to operate doors, hoods, windows, ashtrays etc.

They will discuss the sheets with you when they have completed their section.

Remember, they have other cars that need to be judged and have a tight schedule to get everything done. The best advice I can offer is sit back and relax!

You will get the sheets back in a few weeks. Do your research before changing anything.

IMPORTANT WEATHER NOTICE!

We anticipate that it will be quite warm possibly in the high 90's in the afternoon.

Hence the reason for the moved up (early) start time

Please stay hydrated drink plenty of water, and we suggest you bring an umbrella, hat, sunscreen and make every effort to avoid the sun.

What else to bring:

Remember!!! Make sure you have no more than ¼ tank of gas, Towels or fender covers, a spray bottle for wetting your windshield is helpful. Don't forget the tools for removing items. Bring a chair to sit on.

Lastly, it is suggested that you do an Operations check before you arrive. Many points are lost for simple items not functioning.

Owner Advisory*

*Applies only to FLIGHT JUDGED cars being placed inside the We-Ko-Pah Conference center

Be advised that the facilities Fire Chief has advised us of Fire & Safety Rules that will be in force beginning with the initial placement of cars, and remain in effect until the end of the event.

- No more than ¼ tank or 5 Gallons of gas allowed in the tank while inside the conference center. We have no provisions for removal of fuel.
- As soon as your car enters the facility, it must be turned off and the Battery disconnected before you will be allowed to enter the facility.
- Your car will be pushed into its specific parking location, at which time the driver must exit the vehicle, and they will not be allowed to remain on the judging floor. They will be directed to the nearest exit.

Upon completion of placement of all cars, the field will be opened for owner access. We hope to have this occur by 4 - 5 PM Thursday.

We are under the jurisdiction of the Fort McDowell Indian reservation and thus there will be NO exceptions to these rules. Reservation personnel will be on hand to monitor compliance, non-compliance will halt the placement process.
